When: Saturday, April, 22, 2006

Time: 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Location: Former Old Frankfort Pike landfill, 1631 Old Frankfort Pike, approximately ½ mile inside New Circle Road on the left. Entrance is beyond the landfill onto Jimmie Drive.

Volunteers 16 years and over are also needed for this event. To volunteer for the "Spring Clean" (morning shift is 8 a.m. 1:30 p.m. and afternoon shift is noon to 5:30 p.m.), call LexCall, 425-2255.
